READ THESE NOTICES!!!!

→A parent or guardian is required to attend the parent meeting. The student is only registered for class when their parent/guardian signs them up at the parent meeting.

Forms will be given to parents at the parent meeting to be filled out and brought to the first student class meeting.

→Students must have a valid permit BEFORE the first day of class.

→Students must attend the first day of class or they will be dropped from the class unless the parent prearranges the absence with the instructor. (health/school activity/etc)

Pay close attention to the ending date. The student will likely be finished with the driving portion sometime after that date. If the student gets their license or turns 18 before the date of completion (both classroom and behind-the wheel), then the cost of this course increases. →For students who are 18 years of age or older, the fee is \$200.

→For students who have their driver license before they complete the entire course, the fee is \$200.

Why does it cost more?

The state of Oregon pays for a large part of the cost of taking driver education. This makes the cost to the student lower than it normally would be. The State of Oregon, however, only pays for students who are under 18 and do not yet have their license prior to completion of the program.

Reduced Fee: if a student is eligible for free and reduced lunch, they are also eligible for an additional fee reduction of \$50. You will need to fill out a form that is available at the high school office or from the instructor.
